- This British Standard High Security Nightlatch conforms to British Standard 3621:2017 (BS EN 12209) and meets the tough criteria layed down by insurance companies and the Police
- Features an integral cylinder pull which protects the cylinder from being drilled
- Over 30,000 cut key variations
- Includes 20mm bolt throw for extra strength and security
- Designed ideally for glass panelled wooden doors, as it has been designed with an
 ergonomic internal lockable handle offering added security against forced entry
- Main lock bolt "automatically" deadlocks, this makes the use of credit card to force entry virtually impossible
- The bolt can be held in the withdrawn position (only) with the use of the snib feature
- Brass, Satin chrome, Polished chrome and Satin Nickel finishes are available


1 lock per inner box, 10 locks per outer box

Clam version


1 lock per clam, 2 clams per outer box


Maintenance
